



IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE LIVESTREAM MASS

Communal worship is an integral part of our Catholic faith. Two years ago, in response to an emergency situation, we began offering a livestream Mass so that our parishioners could remain connected to the Sunday liturgy in a way that did not put anyone's health at risk. On March 6th, 2022, Bishop Cantú lifted the dispensation of the Sunday and Holy Day obligation for all Catholics in the Diocese of San Jose. All parishioners who are able to do so, should, at this time, be attending Mass in person.

Taking into consideration the Bishop's directive, as well as ongoing technical issues outside of our control, **As of January 1st we will no longer be offering a livestream Mass.** If you are ill, homebound, have a compromised immune system or are the primary caregiver of someone who is compromised, your dispensation remains in effect. There are neighboring parishes who continue to offer the Mass online as an option for those who are physically unable to attend in person.

We look forward to seeing you again, as we come together to worship our Lord in the Eucharistic celebration.
